Joseph E. Sabol was appointed as an Associate to the American Chemical Society's Committee on Chemistry and Public Affairs for 2015. The CCPA reports to the ACS Board of Directors and is responsible for advice and recommendation for ACS action on public policy matters involving the chemical sciences and technologies, including identifying and analyzing legislative, regulatory, research, and funding policy issues that impact the chemical sciences; engaging other stakeholders within the ACS on courses of action, including preparing official ACS policy statements and providing expert advice to the government on issues concerning the chemical sciences; and providing oversight for the ACS Science Policy Fellowship program and selection process.

The ACS was founded in 1876, has headquarters in Washington DC, and currently has more than 165,000 members; see www.acs.org/ for more information.

In addition to this CCPA appointment, Sabol holds other positions within the ACS: Program Chair for the Division of Small Chemical Businesses, Treasurer for the Upper Peninsula Local Section, and Member of the Great Lakes Region Board.
